About Esophageal Motility

During this test, the muscles of the esophagus and/or the gastroesophageal junction, which propel food and water into the stomach, are studied to measure the pressure of the contraction waves and to diagnose abnormalities in the esophageal muscle that affect swallowing.

Indications for Use

Esophageal Motility is typically ordered for patients with gastroesophageal reflux disease, dysphagia (difficulty swallowing), heartburn, or other esophageal symptoms.
