About the Bravo Capsule

The Bravo Capsule is a small capsule that is temporarily attached to the lining of the esophagus. The capsule gathers pH data for 48 hours to evaluate symptoms of GERD (gastroesophageal reflux disease) and to help your provider determine the most appropriate treatment options.

Indications for Use

The Bravo Capsule is indicated for use in evaluating patients with symptoms of GERD who have had a negative upper endoscopy (EGD) or who have not responded to drug therapy. An EGD is required prior to Bravo Capsule placement to determine where the capsule will be placed in the esophagus.

Billing
