

Mirikizumab-mrkz (OMVOH®) Infusion Price Quote

About OMVOH®

OMVOH® is a prescription biologic medication administered via intravenous (IV) infusion by a health care professional and then self-injected for maintenance dosing. The recommended induction dosage is 300 mg administered by intravenous infusion over at least 30 minutes at weeks 0, 4, and 8. The recommended maintenance dosage is 200 mg administered by subcutaneous injection (given as two consecutive injections of 100 mg each) at week 12, and every 4 weeks thereafter.

Indications for Use

OMVOH® is indicated for the treatment of moderately to severely active ulcerative colitis in adults.

Billing

Listed below are the specific billing codes and associated fees for OMVOH® infusions. After you and your MNGI provider decide to begin OMVOH® treatment, MNGI will partner with you in enrolling in any financial assistance programs for which you may be eligible.
