



## **Certolizumab Pegol (Cimzia®) Injection Price Quote**

### ***About Cimzia®***

Cimzia® is an anti-inflammatory drug treatment which is administered by subcutaneous injection. Cimzia® injections may either be administered by a health care professional or as a self-injection by the patient after s/he receives injection training from a health care professional.

### ***Indications for Use***

Cimzia® is used to reduce the signs and symptoms of active moderate-to-severe Crohn's disease in adult patients who have not responded well to other therapies.

### ***Billing***

After you and your MNGI provider decide to begin Cimzia® treatment, MNGI will partner with you in enrolling in any financial assistance programs for which you may be eligible.

Listed below are the specific codes and fees for Cimzia® injections. One Cimzia® dose requires two separate injections, so you will see the administration fee billed in a quantity of two (2) on your statement. The administration fee is a separate component of the visit and is not included in the cost of the drug. If you obtain Cimzia® from a specialty pharmacy, only the administration fee will appear on your MNGI statement and you will receive a separate statement from the specialty pharmacy for Cimzia®.

The actual allowed amount (the amount of the billed charge deemed payable by an insurance plan) for each charge and the amount of your out-of-pocket expenses will depend on your particular insurance plan. Although CIMplicity can help you to determine insurance coverage for Cimzia® treatment, it is important to direct any additional questions you may have regarding coverage and your financial responsibility to your insurer prior to receiving treatment.
