About Inflectra®

Inflectra® is an anti-inflammatory drug administered via intravenous (IV) infusion by a health care professional.

Indications for Use

Inflectra® has been proven to reduce the signs and symptoms of Crohn's disease and to induce and maintain remission in patients with moderate-to-severe Crohn's whose disease is still active despite treatment with other therapies.

Inflectra® can also reduce the signs and symptoms, induce and maintain remission, promote intestinal healing and reduce or stop the need for steroids in patients with moderate-to-severe ulcerative colitis who have not responded well to other therapies. Ulcerative colitis is a serious and chronic disease. While Inflectra® will not cure ulcerative colitis, it is proven to help many people gain control over their symptoms.

Billing

Listed below are the specific billing codes and associated fees for Inflectra® infusions. The number of vials of Inflectra® used in treatment is based on your weight and the dosage recommended by your provider. On average, most patients receive four to six vials of Inflectra® per infusion. The time it takes to infuse the drug averages between one and two hours. Therefore, for most patients the total amount billed per appointment is estimated between \$4,000-\$6,000, depending on the number of vials and the length of the infusion.

After you and your MNGI provider decide to begin Inflectra® treatment, MNGI will partner with you in enrolling in any financial assistance programs for which you may be eligible.

The actual allowed amount (the amount of the billed charge deemed payable by an insurance plan) for each charge and the amount of your out-of-pocket expenses will depend on your particular insurance plan. Although Pfizer enCompass can help you to determine insurance coverage for Inflectra® treatment, it is important to direct any additional questions you may have regarding coverage and your financial responsibility to your insurer prior to receiving treatment.
