About Stelara®

Stelara® starts with a one-time intravenous (IV) infusion by a health care professional followed by subcutaneous maintenance injections. Stelara® has been proven to reduce the signs and symptoms of moderate to severe Crohn’s disease (CD) when certain other medicines have not worked well enough or cannot be tolerated. While Stelara® will not cure them, it is proven to help many people gain control over their symptoms.

Billing

Listed below are the specific billing codes and associated fees for Stelara® infusions and maintenance injections. The number of vials for the infusion of Stelara® used in the treatment is based on your weight. 2, 3, or 4 vials will be used during that first infusion. Also, listed is the Stelara® maintenance injection with the administration fee.

After you and your MNGI provider decide to begin Stelara® treatment, MNGI will partner with you in enrolling in any financial assistance programs for which you may be eligible.

The actual allowed amount (the amount of the billed charge deemed payable by an insurance plan) for each charge and the amount of your out-of-pocket expenses will depend on your particular insurance plan. Although MNGI can help you to determine insurance coverage for Stelara® treatment, it is important to direct any additional questions you may have regarding coverage and your financial responsibility to your insurer prior to receiving treatment.
